Update from Patti on SBIRT	Patti can train on SBIRT for the 4 or 12 hour course. 4 hour aimed at licensed professionals whereas 12 hours is aimed at non-licensed professionals.
Collaboration w/NYS Academy of Medicine & Suicide Prevention Center of NY on the Prevention Agenda & Trauma Informed Care	Allison presented on the free trainings available through this program. A webinar is coming up on Wednesday this week. The grant runs through June, looking to form a statewide learning collaborative. Need to get your public health office involved. Allison will send information out to group electronically.
Discuss Bridges, Data & Evaluations	Anne-Marie discussed the index and binder of data she had put together based on the June meeting discussions of what the group might find useful for building evaluations for this project. An ask was made for group members to send any useful BH or SU data resource sites to Anne-Marie so she can review them ( <a href="mailto:afitzgerald@ahihealth.org">afitzgerald@ahihealth.org</a> ). A copy of the binder contents will be scanned and sent out electronically to the group by the end of the month.
Write a Mission Statement	The group was asked to answer questions around the purpose for the group and what accomplishments are desired through this project. Allison and Heather will take the groups answers and form a draft mission statement and send out electronically for the group to review by the end of the month.
Discuss Cross Training	A discussion on possibly doing 30 minute webinars on various topics was discussed as a way to execute cross trainings. The suggestion to include local data was put forth. In addition the group through having different sections on a website with webinars geared toward different groups would be useful (i.e. doctors, prevention, community members, etc.).
Review Job Description	After the days discussion the needs of each region were articulated to need a coordinator more than an educator. The job description draft will be revised for the group to review at a later date.
