## Two New DSRIP Whiteboard Videos Released

Two new installments of the NYS Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) Program whiteboard video series have been released. In the first video, “DSRIP: Looking Ahead to 2017,” NYS Medicaid Director, Jason Helgeson, talks about what is ahead for the DSRIP Program in 2017, including the importance of the mid-point assessment and how Value Based Payment (VBP) will fit into and align with DSRIP and its impacts on Medicaid in general.

In the second video, "Myths and Facts of Value Based Payment (VBP) Reform," Helgeson discusses common myths and facts about the Value Based Payment (VBP) initiative. He debunks common misunderstandings about the program and shares what VBP actually means to those who are and will be participating in the initiative.
