The AHI PPS has received a perfect Achievement Value (AV) score for the first quarter of DSRIP Year 2. A PPS earns AVs if they meet DSRIP project milestones for process measures and targets for performance measures. Incentive payments are based on the share of AVs achieved and the AHI PPS earned all 173 AVs available for the quarter.
