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Revalidation of Medicaid Providers

The Affordable Care Act mandates that all Medicaid Providers must be revalidated every five years. Revalidation is to be completed by September 25. Revalidation includes providing information on a provider's ownership, managing employees, agents, persons with a control interest, as well as providing current addresses, specialties, etc.
