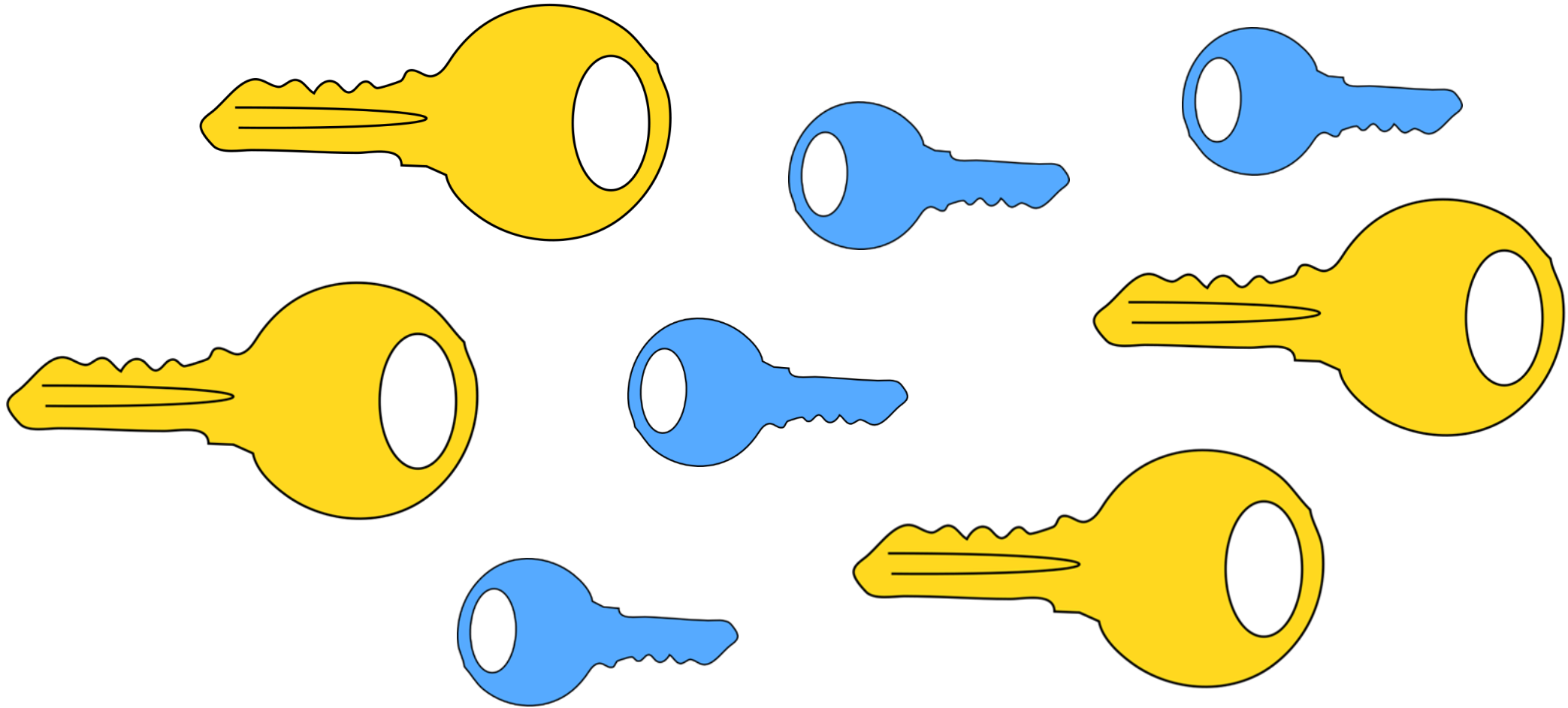

AHI PPS Contracting

AHI has been working to establish a budget and funding distribution plan to allocate DSRIP performance payments among the participating providers in the PPS to achieve the goals of DSRIP. The PPS Finance Committee, PPS Steering Committee, and AHI Board of Directors, in concert with AHI staff, have developed a contracting process and an email was sent to AHI PPS partners regarding the contracting process on March 9.

The AHI PPS is a partnership of nearly 100 organizations formed to plan for and manage Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) health care restructuring in the northern New York/Adirondack region.

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DSRIP Projects

The AHI PPS selected eleven projects with participation from more than 100 partner organizations representing nearly 1,400 providers.

Valuation

The NY State Department of Health (DOH) has valued our projects at nearly \$187 million over five years. This performance based total value assumes all process metrics are achieved and all performance goals (both for PPS and statewide) are met. See PPS financing for specifics.
